Our services include appropriate support for carers, people from diverse cultural and faith backgrounds and veterans.

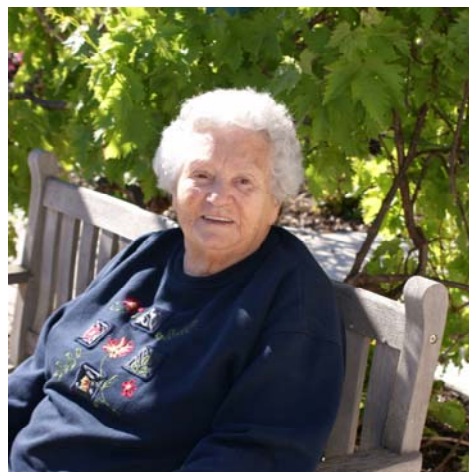

Individual Approach

Your individuality, dignity and quality of life are important to us. Our aim is to assist you to live in comfort and safety in your own home. We discuss with you your physical, social, cultural, spiritual and other special needs, offer choices, listen to you and respect your rights.

Flexible Services

The Care Plan we develop with you may include a range of services, such as: light housework & cleaning, meal preparation, personal care such as showering & dressing, minor home & garden maintenance, transport to appointments, assistance with shopping, after hours emergency support and help to access social, recreational and educational programs.

EACH packages also offer a range of clinical services such as Registered Nursing care, medication assistance, access to aids and equipment, assistance with oxygen or enteral feeding and temporary in-home respite care. Additionally, your Case Manager may refer you to other healthcare services and allied health professionals such as a physiotherapist, dietician, podiatrist or occupational therapist.

We provide culturally appropriate services using bilingual staff wherever possible and understand the special needs of veterans. The services are flexible and are adapted to changes in your needs.

Support for Carers

We appreciate the vital support provided by carers and can provide respite and other services to promote their health and wellbeing.

Caring, Professional Case Manager

A qualified and experienced Case Manager is the primary contact person and will visit and phone you regularly to plan, coordinate and monitor the services so that they meet your needs appropriately.

Who is Eligible?

This service is available for seniors 65 years & over assessed by an Aged Care Assessment Team as requiring a high level of care that can be provided safely at home. You, your family or your GP can request an assessment by an Aged Care Assessment Team, which is free.

Financial Contribution

The Commonwealth Government funds this service for eligible people with high care needs. You will be asked to pay an affordable weekly contribution based on your income. The maximum fee for a pensioner is 17.5% of the basic single rate.
